About the course

The sustained application of evidence-based priority setting has the transformative potential to strengthen the legitimacy, influence, and accountability of government health policies. Health technology assessment (HTA) is one of the tools for evidence based priority setting that leads to efficient use of existing health care resources.

This course will provide both a theoretical and practical understanding of the policy and principles behind the process of HTA. Participants will gain insights into the role of HTA in policy development, its regulatory environment, and be introduced to various components of the process including evidence synthesis, outcome assessment, costing of healthcare services, health economic evaluation and decision analytic modelling.

Designed as a three-day introductory course, this program aims to provide a foundational understanding of HTA processes and economic evaluations. The workshop will be held virtually.
